Fund Description

PowerShares fixed-income portfolios seek to provide income through intelligent indexes that derive their investment decisions from methodologies that incorporate technically advanced and robust institutional investment research.

The PowerShares 1-30 Laddered Treasury Portfolio is based on the Ryan/Mergent 1-30 Year Treasury Laddered Index. The Fund will normally invest at least 90% of its total assets in securities that comprise the Index. The Index measures the potential returns of U.S. Treasury securities with a yield curve based on 30 U.S. Treasury Bonds with fixed coupons, scheduled to mature in a proportional, annual sequential ("laddered") structure.

There are risks involved with investing in ETFs, including possible loss of money. Shares are not actively managed and are subject to risks similar to those of stocks, including those regarding short selling and margin maintenance requirements. Ordinary brokerage commissions apply.

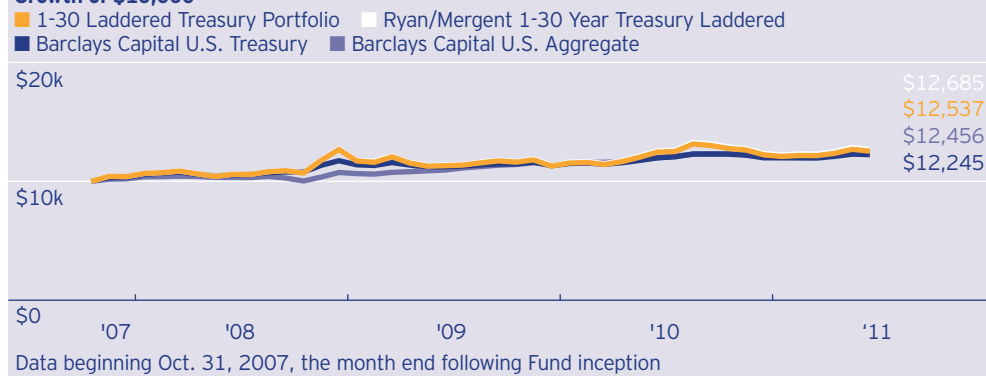

Correlation indicates the degree to which two investments have historically moved in the same direction and magnitude.

Credit ratings are assigned by Nationally Recognized Statistical Rating Organizations based on assessment of the credit worthiness of the underlying bond issuers. The ratings range from AAA (highest) to D (lowest) and are subject to change. Not rated indicates the debtor was not rated, and should not be interpreted as indicating low quality. Modified Duration is a measure of a bond's sensitivity to interest rate changes that reflects the change in a bond's price given a change in yield.

This duration measure is appropriate for option-free bonds.
